- 3) hydraulic analysis and modeling using computer programs such as HEC-RAS or other FEMA approved methods;
- 4) performing hydrologic analyses;
- 5) field surveys for ground control and field data collection;
- 6) researching available background data;
- 7) topographic mapping; and
- 8) performing floodplain studies.
